Information

We are seeking individuals to be champions for Staffordshire Search and Rescue Team. We are Staffordshire's only search and rescue team and comprise 100% professionally-trained volunteers. The team is funded by public donations.

Pre-requisites

- Access to reliable transport to travel to parts of Staffordshire (and beyond)
- Be at least 18 years old
- Complete a DBS and Safeguarding Training
- Be able to attend a proportion fundraising events with other team members (once a month)
- For the safety of yourself, other team members, and our insurers, it is a requirement that the Clinical Lead is made aware of ANY medical condition(s) which may affect your ability to fulfil your role. Similarly, you MUST declare any serious life-threatening illness or condition past or present.

Responsibilities

1. Interact with the public and be a champion for the charity
2. Be a source of information for members of the public (training given)
3. Be willing to attend a variety of fundraising events, in a variety of formats (e.g. events, sales, shows, community, one-of-a-kind)
4. To act as an exemplar of professional behaviour at all times
